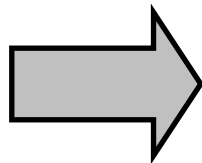
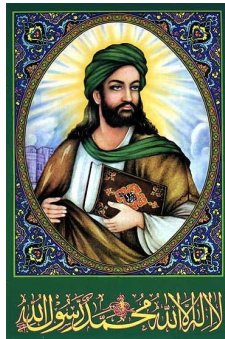
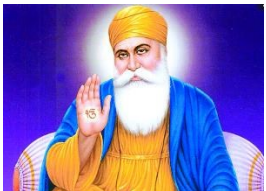


Key Questions
