Key Facts


- Christians believe Jesus is the promised messiah as the incarnation of God.

- Muslims believe that both Abraham and Jesus are viewed as prophets and Muhammad was the last prophet.
- Believers see miracle stories such as Moses and the 10 plagues and Noah and the rainbow as evidence of God.
- Hindus believe in Brahman and the Trimurti (creator - Brahma, Vishnu—sustainer and Shiva- destroyer).
- God promised to send a Messiah to the descendants of Abraham in the Old Testament.
