You will need to bring a book bag and a water bottle with you.

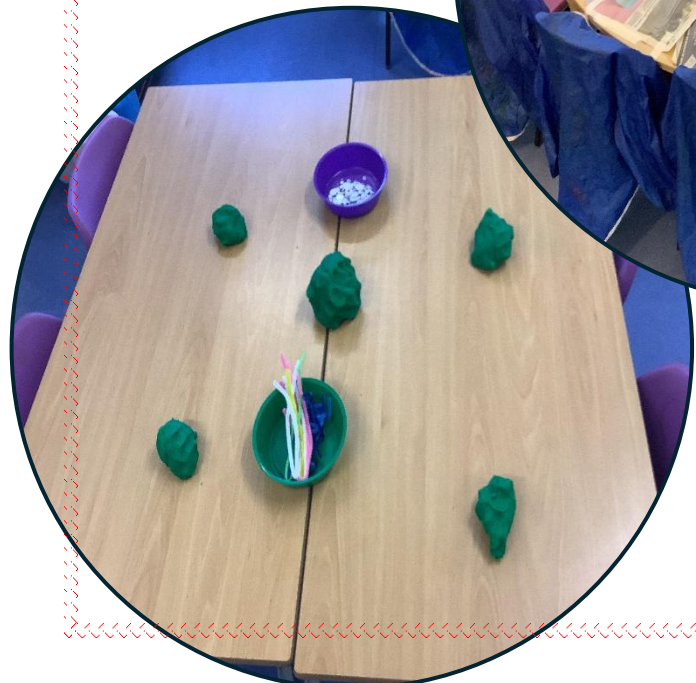
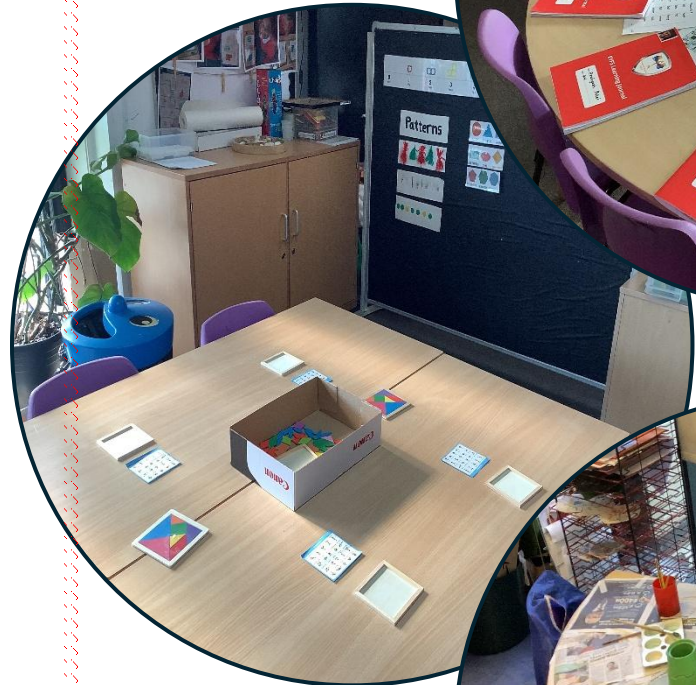


About Reception

Sometimes you will learn with one of your teachers and sometimes you will be able to choose which area you learn in.

Sometimes you will sit on the carpet with a group of the other children in your class.

When you are on the carpet your teacher will take the register, read you a story, teach you something new or tell you about something you need to do.

There are 4 reception outdoor areas.

Physical Zone



Fine Motor Zone



Role Play Zone



Understanding of the world Zone



You will be able to use the outdoor area each day unless the weather is too bad!

When you come into school, you will look for your peg and hang your coat up. You will put your water bottle in the water tray and put your book bag in your tray. You will then sit on the carpet and wait for your teacher to teach you.



If you are having a packed lunch, you will put your lunch box next to the water tray.



Toilets

Each class has toilets and sinks for the boys and girls to share.

Dinner Hall

You will be at school all day so you will have lunch in the hall.

You will go for lunch at 11.15am, this will give you plenty of time to eat it. You will have lunch first, as this is when the dining hall will be quieter and not too busy.

Your teacher and the dinner ladies will help you choose the food you want to eat. You will use a knife and fork to eat lunch, but you can ask for help if you need it.

P.E.

You will go to the hall for PE
with Mr Thomas the sports coach.



You will come to school dressed in your PE
kit every Monday.

You will play some games and learn new
skills such as balancing or throwing and
catching a ball.

Music

You will have music with Miss Turner the music teacher.



This will be every Monday afternoon.

You will learn how to play some simple instruments and lots of new songs and rhymes.

Computing

You will have computing with Miss Haines
the computing teacher.



This will be every Monday afternoon.

You will learn how to use some simple
equipment such as the whiteboard and
create pictures using a computer.

Nature Garden

You will visit the nature garden with Mrs Sear



This will be once a week if it is safe to do so.

You will learn how to build dens, look after plants, create bug homes and other fun activities.

Home Time

At the end of the school day, your teacher will read you a story and then you will:

1. Get your coat on
2. Collect your book bag from your tray
3. Collect your water bottle and lunch box

When all of the children are ready, you will sit quietly on the carpet and listen to your teacher.

Your grown up will be waiting in the reception outdoor area.

Your teacher will open your classroom door and when they see your adult, they will call your name and you will be able to go home.
